



Daily Cleaning Procedure

STEP 1

Isolate the electrical supply and remove the Dryer Cover from the base.

STEP 2

Clean the top of the cover using a damp cloth. Clean the underside of the cover using a damp cloth, paying particular attention to the air nozzles and base matting surfaces.

STEP 3

The base is split into two sections.

Airflow Area

Clean using a damp cloth.


Drain Outlet

Clean using a proprietary cleaning agent. Rinse out with fresh water, ensuring that the water vacates down the drain holes.


STEP 4

Reassemble the unit, reconnect the electrical supply and operate several cycles before use.

AIRACK Care Card



Do not use proprietary cleaning agents. The odours will contaminate the glasses.



Cautionary Notes

- ✓ Always use a full load of glasses and place the basket centrally onto the Airack (top is recessed for location – Fig 1).
- ✓ Ensure the correct orientation of compartmented baskets. The glasses should be tilted forward to the front of the Airack (Fig 2).
- ✓ Never use the Airack for dregs, or liquid disposal.
- ✓ Never use the Airack for any other purpose other than drying glassware.




Using The Airack



Switch on the power to the Airack.



At the end of the drying cycle (neon goes out) the unit will automatically switch off and will remain off until the button is pressed again.



Immediately after the washing process, place a full basket of glasses on top of the unit and press the button to start the drying cycle. The neon will light up.



When the drying cycle is complete, remove the basket of clean dry glasses for immediate use, or to storage.
